

Continuing Ministerial Development (CMD)

AppliesTo: All Clergy (except IME Phase 2 and Clergy and Chaplains paid by external institutions)

The purpose of Continuing Ministerial Development funding is to help support your own personal development.

CMD Process

- Allocation of CMD funding must be approved by the relevant Archdeacon before permission is given for funds to be released.
- You must apply for funding **before the event** otherwise no funds will be released.
- The level of funding you receive may depend on the amount you have already received in the current year.
- Priority will be given to applications connected to your MDR development objectives.
- It is your responsibility to book and pay for the event.
- The diocese reimburses you directly and has no contact with the organisers of your event.
- CMD funds **cannot** be used to claim for; retreats, travel expenses, subsistence, holiday conferences (e.g. New Wine), spiritual direction, *accommodation or training materials (e.g. books). Please claim these direct from the parish as part of your working expenses.
- Allow up to four weeks for processing

**Exceptions regarding accommodation claims are when it is inclusive with the fee for residential courses/conferences.*

How to Apply

If you wish to attend a course or conference:

- Complete the CMD application form and return to the Archdeacon by email or post.
- Attach **supporting documentation** showing the cost and details of the event.
- Funds cannot be release without this information.

Diocesan Training Events

The Diocese also run a programme of training events throughout the year. If you have particular interests, or would like to make suggestions for the CMD programme, please let us know. Events organised by the Diocese are automatically approved for CMD funds and are exempt from needing an application form.
