They are not intended to be at all prescriptive, but to show that we can and should pray in all sorts of times and places, and to give you ideas so that you can form prayers of your own as the Spirit moves you.

School

Lord Jesus Christ, who showed on earth your love for children: guide, we pray, with your Spirit, those called to the ministry of teaching in (this parish/our school/this town); that nothing may stop the children from growing in faith and love toward you, and that your name may be honoured in our schools and homes.

Father, please help children to benefit from all aspects of school life: the environment and ethos, academic learning, music, arts, sport and provision for spiritual and emotional wellbeing.

School governors and leaders

Help us to work for a better world, where the young are given the chance to flourish, where the poor's dream for justice can come true, and where God's compassion is shown to be real.

Dear Jesus, please inspire and equip those in our schools who love you to be faithful, loving, bold and wise ambassadors for the gospel, through their words and lives wherever they are.

Shop(s)

Thank you Lord for our village shop, and for all the hard work that N does to make it useful to the community. Help us all to see the benefit of keeping things local, especially for the lonely or those who find it hard to travel, and make it a place where we can all show love and care for your name's sake.

Pub

O Lord, who enjoyed food and drink when you walked in Galilee, I'm glad we have the (name of pub) in our village/town, where people can gather as friends and enjoy good food and moderate refreshment.
