We continue to pray that more lives will be transformed and that more people will come to know Christ across our diocese's communities, villages, and towns.

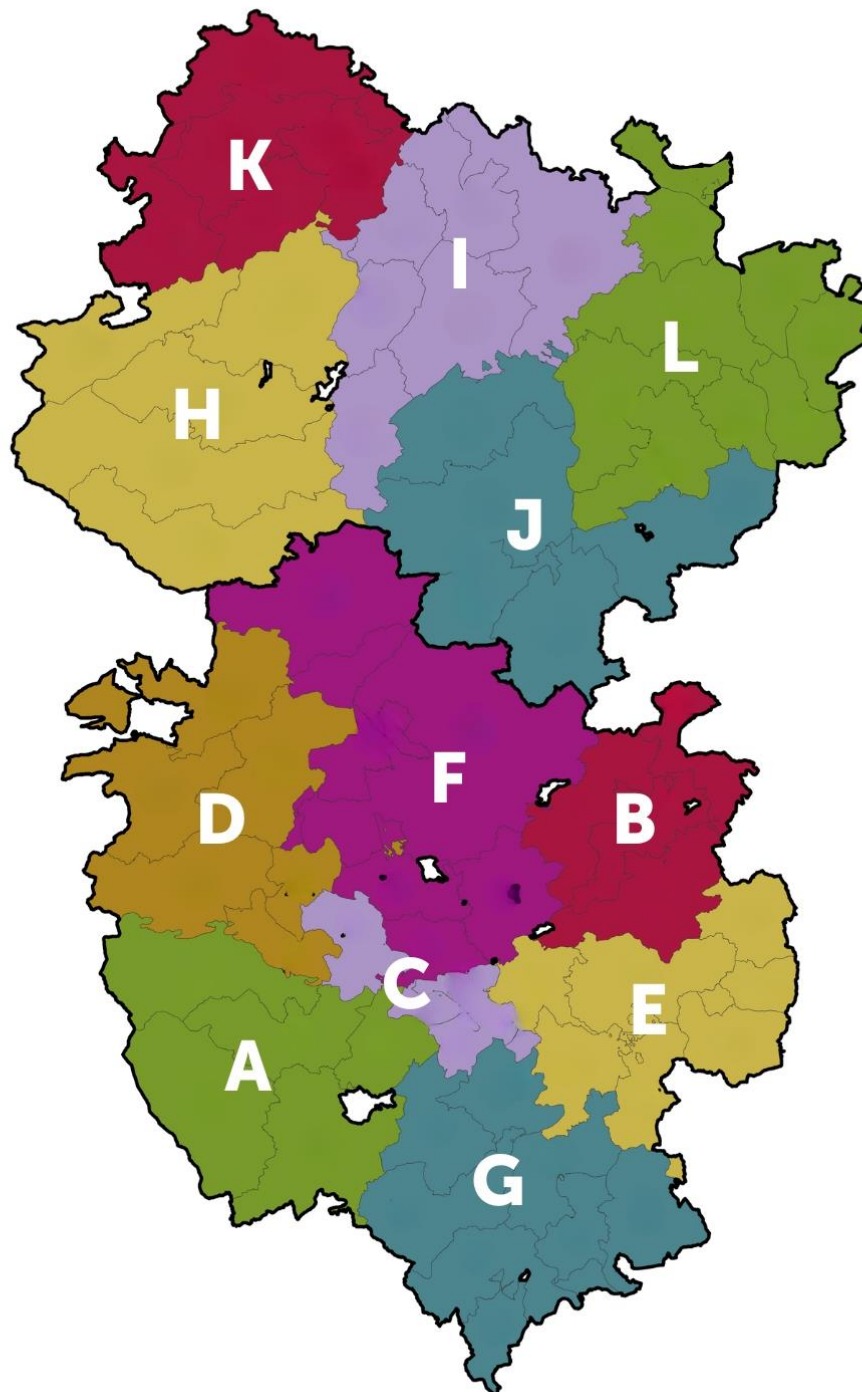

# The Prayer Diary - October to November 2025

We are moving to a new format, and so this prayer diary may feel different to previous years. Starting in advent 2025 we will be moving to a new design! The main part of this Prayer Diary covers the quarter from **Sunday 5th October to Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> November**, week by week, under the following headings:

- **Anglican** - Taken from the Anglican Cycle of Prayer and updated as fully and accurately as possible, so that we can pray with confidence with and for the Anglican Communion worldwide.
- **Hereford** – A bidding for each day, with each of our twelve deaneries being prayed for over the course of a year, interspersed with the wider needs of the diocese.
- **Porvoo** - This weekly bidding pairs the Lutheran churches of the Nordic and Baltic areas and the Anglican churches of the British Isles and of Spain and Portugal, which have signed the Porvoo Declaration recognising each other's ministries. Also included is the Latvian Church, which has not yet taken a decision on signing the Declaration, and the Church of Denmark, which has not signed but wishes to develop links with the churches which have signed.
- **The Wider View** - Biddings and promptings for prayer relating to world mission and development, including our own World Church links, among them our companion links with the Kirchenkreis Nürnberg in Germany, and the Tanzanian dioceses of Tanga, Dar es Salaam, Masasi and Newala.
- **Today** – Focuses on specific things happening in the life of our diocese or the wider Church of England such as churchwarden visitations, General Synod meetings and ordinations.
- **This Week** - Focuses on themes and issues for prayer during the week, in healthcare, the community, education and the changing seasons.
- **Collect** – The Anglican Collect for the Sunday prior.
