There will be two workshop sessions at each event, morning and afternoon. All participants are invited to select two options from the following list. Due to space limitations at each venue, once places are filled (30 max per workshop), the bookings will be closed and participants will be asked to choose an alternative. A number of the sessions have been designed to suit people of all ages including children, young people and families. There is also outdoor space at each venue depending on the weather it may be possible for children and young people to play outdoors but we are unable to offer supervision.

- Older people's ministry with BRF: Anna Chaplaincy – This session outlines how Anna Chaplains working in churches across our diocese are supporting older people. We hope to inspire others to step into this lay ministry as leaders and to work with older people in our wider community.
- Intergenerational Mission, Messy and Youth Ministry – This is a workshop that will share our experiences from across the diocese of working with people of all ages and backgrounds to grow faith. The intergenerational mission experience has focussed on families, younger people and children and we have also seen growth in Messy Church groups across churches in rural areas and market towns. This will be an opportunity to experience, share and learn together.
- Living generously in our everyday faith – the practical guide to generosity and giving being lived out in churches across our diocese. Hear some inspiring stories and how generosity has made a difference to people's lives.
- Growing The Rural Church – We may never have large numbers coming to our rural churches, but we are still the church, present in every community. Explore how many churches across our diocese are building stronger links with their local communities and offering that reassuring presence as the face of the church in these turbulent times.
- Generous Buildings – practical tips, insights and a simple guide to creating welcoming spaces using outdoor spaces, schools and churches to offer a warm welcome. Live out our faith in practical ways as money advice centres, eco after-school clubs, foodbanks, and much more.
- Let us Pray – Take time out for some quiet reflection and prayer. We will also be offering examples of creative prayer stations for churches and school. Try it out and take away resources to help you build your own prayer spaces at home, at work or at school.
